The following prehearing requirements must be followed:

- **Pre-filed Exhibits.** By January 31, 2022, the parties must:
 - pre-file all exhibits they intend to offer at the hearing on the merits;
 - provide the exhibits to the other party by email;
 - number each exhibit sequentially; and
 - paginate or bates stamp multipage documents.
 - Exhibits that are not pre-filed may be excluded from evidence.

- **Witness Identification.** By January 31, 2022, the parties must file a witness statement:
 - Identify each witnesses you will call to testify;
 - Mention what each witness will testify about; and
 - Estimate how long each witness will testify.
 - Failure to identify a witness may result in the witness being excluded from testifying.

- **Witness Preparation.** Before the hearing, the parties must do the following:
 - Give each witness the information to access the meeting listed above;
 - Give each witness all documents needed to participate in the hearing; and
 - Have each witness's contact information available so additional documents can be provided to each witness during the hearing if needed.

All other deadlines are also reset in connection with the new hearing date.
